In June of 2025, the ALC-Hospital, Medicaid, and Developmental Disabilities Study Subcommittee initiated a comprehensive review of the Department of Human Services (DHS) in accordance with Section 13 of Act 1004 of 2025. This review aims to assess the operational integrity and overall effectiveness of DHS in fulfilling its mission to serve the community.
