Arkansas Adult Education Centers offer a variety of FREE services that can help Arkansans improve their job outlook and earnings with basic skills courses and specialized workforce training. Our programs provide flexible schedules and allow students to work at a pace that fits their lives. Classes can be taken face-to-face, through distance learning or a combination of both. We also offer evening classes and weekend classes when available.

- 463K+ individuals have passed the GED® test and earned their Arkansas High School Diploma since 1966.
- Last year, Adult Ed helped 2,797 adults earn their Arkansas High School Diploma.
- Since 2018, over 8,125 certifications and credentials have been earned by adult learners in Adult Ed Centers or through partnerships with Training Providers.
- 2,155 adult learners, a 66% increase over last year, earned a WAGETM Level I Workforce Preparation certificate.
- Arkansas Adult Ed ranks 2nd in the nation on the GED® pass rate.

Arkansas Adult Education

Arkansas Adult Education provides basic literacy and education for adults to improve their foundational academic skills. We offer supportive services through our partners that can help with transportation, childcare and tuition to those who qualify.

Adult Basic Education

Adult basic education provides basic skills instruction in reading, writing, and math to adult learners functioning below the ninth-grade level.

College & Career Readiness Training
