

SCAT provides public transportation across Region E, serving 19 counties in South Central Arkansas. We keep essential rides running every day, helping people reach medical appointments, jobs, education, and daily necessities across small towns and rural roads. The figures below highlight our 2025 service activity and the fleet resources required to deliver reliable coverage across a large, rural service area.

Operating Environment

SCAT operates across a large rural service area where trip distances, travel time, and broad county coverage are part of daily service delivery. Service planning and dispatch coordination are designed to keep rides moving consistently, including regular runs and day-of adjustments when conditions change.
