Dear Ms. Garrity:

Enclosed please find a Litigation Reporting Form pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-3-312 for the above-referenced case. Because the form would not allow a full recitation of the relief sought, I am explaining it more fully here:

Declaratory judgment that federal law preempts APSC Order; APSC Order violates Dormant Commerce Clause; federal law requires new APSC Order authorizing retail recovery; and federal law prohibits ordering bandwidth credit to retail customers while denying recovery of FERC payment from customers. Permanent injunction requiring withdrawal of APSC Order; requiring APSC Order authorizing recovery of FERC payment from customers; and prohibiting ordering bandwidth credit to retail customers while denying recovery of FERC payment from customers. Declaratory judgment, pursuant to Arkansas law, that APSC Order is arbitrary and capricious and not supported by substantial evidence. Permanent injunction, pursuant to Arkansas law, requiring withdrawal of APSC order; and requiring issuance of APSC Order authorizing recovery of FERC payment from customers. Attorneys' fees and costs.
