#### **State Accountability**

The purpose of the Arkansas Educational Support and Accountability System is to ensure all children have access to opportunities for a high-quality education and to make progress in closing long-standing achievement gaps.

#### **Federal Accountability**

The purpose of the ESSA School Index is to:

- **Inform educators and stakeholders** about school quality and student success as well as the progress and outcomes of schools' and districts' continuous improvement efforts.
- Identify underperforming schools and subgroups of students within schools and notify district leaders when schools within their systems are most in need of the district's support to achieve immediate and sustained improvement.
- **Provide support that will empower districts** to uncover the needs of their underperforming schools and/or student subgroups and enable districts to implement evidence-based strategies to address those needs.

- ESSA School Index Score for All Students and Subgroups
- Participation Requirements for State Assessments (at least 95% for ELA and Math)
- Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI)
- Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI)



- 72.4% (728) retained the same letter grade in 2023 as in 2022
- 14.5% (148) earned a higher letter grade in 2023
- 14.1% (144) earned a lower letter grade in 2023


#### **Featured Schools**

(meeting requirements of all four categories)

Public School Ratings, ESSA School Index Scores, and Weighted Achievement Scores were compared between 2023 and 2022 to identify schools which made the most continuous improvement over the span of time. Value-Added Growth Scores for 2023 were evaluated to identify schools who scored two standard deviations above the mean. Five schools, three elementary and two high schools, earned the distinction as a Schools on the Move Towards Excellence Featured School by meeting the requirements for all four categories!




Public School Rating (*Letter Grade*) & ESSA School Index Increases of 5+ points from 2021 to 2022 <u>148</u> schools increased their

Weighted Achievement Increases from 2021 to 2022

- <u>524</u> schools increased their weighted achievement score
- <u>24</u> schools increased their weighted achievement scores by 10 or more points
  - 13 Elementary
  - 2 Middle School
  - 9 High School



# Value-Added Growth better than 97.5% of schools

(2 standard deviations above the mean in 2022)

- <u>540</u> schools earned 80 or more points for student growth
- <u>25</u> schools earned growth scores higher than 97.5% of other schools in their respective grade spans

  - 15 Elementary
  - 5 Middle School
  - 5 High School
