## District Resource Use and Practices Survey

- Many of today's presentations will include results from the District Resource Use and Practices Survey
- The survey was administered to all district superintendents and charter system directors in July
- Received responses from 181 districts and charter systems
- 72 percent of districts and 48 percent of charter systems
- Responses generally representative of the state as a whole


## Disaggregation Quintiles/Categories

- The study team disaggregated responses to the survey or available data by size, need (FRL percentage), wealth (assessed value/ADM) and/or locale (urban/suburban vs. rural)
- The following slide provides some descriptive data of the quintiles, including average size, need, or wealth, percentage of districts and percentage of students
