

Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program	A loan repayment program	Teachers who have been employed as a full-time, highly qualified teacher for five complete and consecutive academic years at a school serving low-income students	Up to \$17,500 for secondary math and science teachers or special education teachers Up to \$5,000 for all other teachers	You may apply anytime	http://bit.ly/TeacherLF
