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| 25 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: |
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| 27 | SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-1-101 is amended to read as follows: |
| 28 | 6-11-101. Members. |
| 29 | (a)(1) The State Board of Education shall be composed of nine (9) members, each of whom is |
| 30 | elected in the manner required under the general election laws of this state as follows: |
| 31 | (1)(A) Two (2) members to be selected elected from each of the congressional |
| 32 | districts of the state as they exist on the July 31, 2007 ; and |
| 33 | (2)(B) One (1) member to be appointed elected as a member at large from within |
| 34 | the state. |
| 35 | (2) A candidate shall file for office with the Secretary of State in the manner required |
| 6 | under the general election laws of this state. |

| 1 | (b) (1) The term of office of a member of the state board shall be for a single term of seven (7) |
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| 2 | years <u>:</u> |
| 3 | (1)(A) Shall be four (4) years. |
| 4 | (B) The terms shall be staggered as follows: |
| 5 | (i) One (1) member from each congressional district shall serve an initial |
| 6 | term of two (2) years; |
| 7 | (ii) One (1) member from each congressional district shall serve an initial |
| 8 | term of four (4) years; and |
| 9 | (iii) The member-at-large shall serve an initial term of four (4) years; |
| 0 | (2) Shall be limited to two (2) four-year terms; and |
| 1 | (3) Shall begin on January 1 and end on December 31. |
| 12 | (2)(A) Any member appointed to the state board to fill a vacancy for an uncompleted |
| 3 | term with less than three (3) years remaining on the original term may be reappointed to an additional |
| 4 | term of seven (7) years. |
| 15 | (B) No member serving-three-(3)-or more years on the state board may be |
| 16 | reappointed. |
| 17 | (3) No-current or new member shall be allowed to resign in order to be appointed to a |
| 18 | new term on the state board. |
| 19 | (4) Nothing in this section-shall be construed to change the terms of any member of the |
| 20 | state board-who was-appointed prior to June 3, 2004. |
| 21 | (c) The membership of the state board-shall-reflect-the diversity in general education. |
| 22 | (d)(1) No person may serve as a member of the state board unless he or she is a qualified |
| 23 | elector and is a person of high moral standards and recognized ability. |
| 24 | (2)(c) A member of the state board: |
| 25 | (1) Shall be a qualified elector who is twenty-five (25) years of age or older; |
| 26 | (2) For a position representing a congressional district, shall be a resident of the |
| 27 | congressional district from which he or she is seeking election for one (1) year preceding the election; and |
| 28 | (3) Shall not be: |
| 29 | (A) Neither the The Commissioner of Education nor any; |
| 30 | (B) A candidate for <u>any other</u> public office ₇ ; |
| 31 | (C) The holder of a public office in the state, |
| 32 | (D) schoolteacher An employee of a public school or school district in this state; |
| 33 | (E) A county or city superintendent; |
| 34 | (F) An employee of a state-supported college or university, institution of higher |
| 35 | education: or |

| 1 | (G) A member of any board of trustees of any state a state-supported institution |
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| 2 | of higher learning-shall serve as a member of the state board education in this state. |
| 3 | (e)(d) The members of the state board shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to the |
| 4 | confirmation of the Senate and shall take the oath of office for officers prescribed by the Arkansas |
| 5 | Constitution. |
| 6 | (f)(1)(e)(1) Whenever a vacancy occurs in the membership of the state board by death, |
| 7 | resignation, or removal from office, the Governor shall appoint a successor who shall serve the remainder |
| 8 | of the unexpired term of the member that whom he or she succeeded, subject to all other provisions of |
| 9 | this section. |
| 10 | (2) Resignation, removal from the district from which he or she is appointed, |
| 11 | disqualification, incapacitation from mental or physical disability or otherwise, or change in status from the |
| 12 | eligibility requirements for membership on the state board shall automatically create a vacancy in the |
| 13 | membership of the state board, and no such-member shall thereafter exercise any of the functions of |
| 14 | membership on the state-board even though his or her successor has not been appointed <u>The Governor</u> |
| 15 | shall fill a vacancy with a person who meets the qualifications for the position vacated. |
| 16 | (g)(1) Members of the state board shall be subject to removal from office by the Governor when |
| 17 | the actions or condition of a member shall be considered as sufficient cause for removal. |
| 18 | (2) However, before a member may be removed for cause, this cause must-have been |
| 19 | accepted as true, good, and sufficient by a majority written vote of all members of the state board after a |
| 20 | formal hearing at a regular or special session of the state board. |
| 21 | (h)(f) The members of the state board shall serve without remuneration but may receive expense |
| 22 | reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq., as follows: |
| 23 | (1) Actual expenses while attending regular and special meetings of the state board; and |
| 24 | (2) A per diem allowance when in attendance at regular or special meetings of the state |
| 25 | board. |
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| 27 | SECTION 2. <u>TEMPORARY LANGUAGE</u> . <u>DO NOT CODIFY.</u> |
| 28 | (a) The first election of members of the State Board of Education under this act shall be the 2014 |
| 29 | general election. |
| 30 | (b)(1) The term of a person who is a member of the state board on the effective date of this act |
| 31 | or who is appointed to the state board after the effective date of this act and before the 2014 general |
| 32 | election shall expire on December 31, 2014. |
| 33 | (2) A person who is a member of the state board before the 2014 general election and |
| 34 | who meets all other qualifications for members under this act is eligible to be a candidate for a position on |
| 35 | the state board in the 2014 general election. |

| 1 | (c) At the first regular meeting of the state board following the election, the members |
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| 2 | representing each of the four (4) congressional districts shall draw for staggered terms as provided under |
| 3 | this act. |
