11	(b) Meetings or consultations of a state-supported institution of postsecondary or higher
12	education for the purpose of developing or instituting a policy, procedure, or plan to ensure campus
13	security or a safe learning environment for students and school employees shall be treated as confidential
14	and are exempt from public disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967. § 25-19-101 et seq.
