# Why change?

- Reach all students
  - APSRC: Rural Education Model
  - Examine Past Successes/Challenges
- Senior Survey: 60% enter a post-secondary institution, 5% join the military, 10% go to a sustaining work experience—the remaining 25% are employed at minimum wage/unemployed.
- Only 1 out of every 4 Southside students that enter UACCB completes a program of study









## **Benefits of Technical Paths**

When a student graduates from high school, he or she will be ready for a job that pays above minimum wage.
