Arkansas Code 21-5-414. State contributions generally — Partial state contribution of employees' premiums.

## Statute text

- (a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall seek the advice of the Legislative Council and the House Committee on Insurance and Commerce and the Senate Committee on Insurance and Commerce before additional contributions can be made.
- (b)(1) The State of Arkansas, on behalf of agencies participating in the plans adopted by the state, is authorized to make a monthly contribution equal to the number of budgeted state employee positions multiplied by the monthly contribution authorized by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, not to exceed four-hundred twenty-five dollars (\$425) three hundred ninety dollars (\$390) monthly for each state employee budgeted position into a fund designated for state employee health benefits, to partially defray the cost of life and health insurance for employees of the state participating in the plan sponsored by the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance Board.
- (2) The department may make a monthly contribution to partially defray the cost of health insurance for state employee retirees, utilizing funds made available for that purpose, not to exceed the amount authorized by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
