E-Cell House Arrest Bit (HABIT) wrist-worn band patent-pending E-Cell House Arrest Admin App patent-pending E-Cell House Arrest Offender App for smartphones

E-Cell Alternative Sentencing Benefits

- <u>Costs Savings</u>- \$1.50 to \$5.00/ day vs. \$66/day for incarceration (Vera, 2012)
- <u>Increased Compliance</u> electronic monitoring compared to other forms of community supervision reduced the risk of failure to comply by 31%. (Bales et al. 2010)
- Behavior Modification
 - Increased communication with probation, courts, and other law enforcement.
 - Daily attainable goals, ex. Phillips County.
 - Removal of social stigma associated with ankle bracelets
- <u>Streamline Probation</u>
 - Dashboard Monitoring Center
 - Offender Scorecard
 - Real-Time communication with offenders

Level One – Low-Level Offender

Monitored using the E-Cell House Arrest Offender App

- Track Only using E-Cell House Arrest App
- Voluntary Check-Ins
- Real-Time GPS Location
- Electronic Documentation: Court Order, Terms of House Arrest Agreement, Offender Information Order Form, Violation Form, and Tracking History.
- Communication via Voice Call, Text, FaceTime, and E-Mail.

Level Two – Low-to-Medium-Level Offender

Monitored using the E-Cell House Arrest Offender App

- Randomly Generated and Voluntary Check-ins
- Geofence Technology for Home, Work, Restricted Areas, and Curfews
- Electronic Documentation (Same as Level One) plus customized forms upon request.
- Real-Time GPS Monitoring (Same as Level One)
- Communication (Same as Level One)

Level Three – Medium-to-High-Level Offender

Increased Monitoring with the E-Cell HABIT Band & E-Cell House Arrest Offender App

- Secures to the wrist with a tamper-proof lock
- Syncs to the offender's phone
- Provides Discrete Monitoring--similar in design to a fitness band (i.e. FitBit, Jawbone)
- Secures the offender to the phone and app, offender has to stay within 20 feet or an alert
- Plus all Level 1 & 2 monitoring features & compliance requirements






E-Cell House Arrest Offender App Check-Ins Screen


E-Cell House Arrest Offender App Check-In Confirmation Screen

Offender enters randomly-generated code

Takes "selfie" video or photo

Offender Check-in Requests by date/time Lists all Random and Voluntary Check-Ins Shows successful and missed Check-ins






E-Cell House Arrest Offender App Location Map Screen

E-Cell House Arrest Admin App

- All offenders (by region or probation officer) can be viewed on the Dashboard Monitoring Center. Offenders are color-coded to quickly view which ones are compliant and those who need immediate attention.
- Individual Scorecard
- Geofences
- Communication via voice call, text, FaceTime, and e-mail.
- GPS location app updates every 60 seconds
- Tracking history shows all movements for designated time period
- Violations electronically documented and can be sent via secure e-mail to any designated site
- Court and probation electronic documentation






Client Locations hybrid and standard map views

All Offender movements are recorded and can be viewed for requested time periods.







E-Cell House Arrest Admin App Geofencing

Geofencing can be established around an offender's home, work, and other permitted locations.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

- Q: How secure is the App and Data?
- A: Very. We use the same type of server and encryption as Wells Fargo Bank.
- Q: What if the offender doesn't answer the phone?
- Q: What if they don't keep their phone charged?
- Q: What if they delete the app?
- Q: What if someone else checks in for the offender?
- Q: Couldn't the offender just leave their phone and walk away?

All of the above could potentially result in Failure to Comply Violations. When the offender is first enrolled in an electronic monitoring program, the rules, regulations, and punishments are clearly explained, and the offender must sign an Agreement of Understanding. However, electronic monitoring is best offered to offenders who are incentivized by the opportunity to avoid harsher penalties and/or potential (re)incarceration.

- Q: Who owns the data?
- A: The State.
- Q: Can an offender use his/her own smart phone?
- A: Yes, as long as it is able to run the app and function properly.
