

Long Term Care COVID-19 Update

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Long Term Care Cases (as of 6/18/20)

- ADH is following 114 facilities, 91 have active cases, 23 no longer have active cases
- 569 total positive residents
- 228 recovered residents
- 84 patient deaths
- 389 positive health care workers
- 170 recovered health care workers

Statewide Testing

- Statewide testing initiative for all long term care patients and staff during month of June.
- Goals:
 - Establish statewide baseline of long term care population
 - Identify positive asymptomatic workers and staff
 - Path for reopening



Statewide Testing

Total reported results: 24,557

Total positive results: 198

Total facilities with positive results: 43

Total facilities with results: 184



Reopening Plan

- Facilities meeting new criteria will be eligible for limited reopening effective July 1st. (ADH, 6/17/20)
- Includes expansion of visitation, communal dining, activities, and barber/beauty salons within facilities.
- Facilities with active resident cases cannot accommodate visitors until cases are cleared.
- End of life visits will continue.
- Individual facility approach, not all facilities will be ready to open on 7/1/20.



Reopening Plan

- Facility visits will look much different than in the past.
 - Visitors must schedule time to visit
 - Masks must be worn during the visit, maintaining 6' distance
 - Maximum of 2 visitors per resident at any given time
 - Limited visiting hours
 - Outdoor visits preferred, indoor visits allowed when weather or resident condition prohibits
