EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that many Arkansans who are 13 diagnosed with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), or severe acute 14 respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) or any of its mutations, may 15 not be able to pay insurance premiums, prompting nonrenewal or cancellation 16 17 of an insurance policy and thereby causing unnecessary and undue stress; that 18 providing affected policyholders with the ability to apply for a grace period 19 of up to sixty (60) days could reduce the number of nonrenewal and 20 cancellations of insurance policies in the state due to nonpayment of insurance premiums; and that this act is immediately necessary because 21 22 Arkansans who are diagnosed with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), or 23 severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) or any of its mutations, need insurance to protect their lives and property in Arkansas. 24 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately 25 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall 26 27 become effective on: 28 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 29 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 30 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 31 bill; or 32 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 33 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto. 34
