SUBJECT: 1098 Appeals and Hearings Procedure

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: The Director of the Department of Human Services is proposing revisions to the DHS Office of Appeals and Hearings Policy 1098 to provide specific protection for minor witnesses and victims testifying in DCFS maltreatment hearings and adult maltreatment hearings.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No public hearing was held. The public comment period expired on April 26, 2018. The Department received no comments:

The Executive Committee reviewed and approved this rule on an emergency basis on March 5, 2018.

The proposed effective date for the permanent rule is June 29, 2018.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: There is no financial impact.

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION: The Department of Human Services (DHS) is authorized to "make rules and regulations and take actions as are necessary or desirable to carry out the provisions of this chapter [Public Assistance] and that are not inconsistent therewith." Arkansas Code Annotated § 20-76-201 (12).

The Department's Division of Children and Family Services (DCFS) has the power to promulgate rules necessary to administer the laws that address protecting children from abuse and neglect and providing services and support to promote the safety, permanency, and well-being of Arkansas children and families. *See* Ark. Code Ann. §89-28-101 and 103. Further, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 12-18-105, DHS and the State Police are authorized to promulgate rules to implement the Child Maltreatment Act, which includes a subchapter on administrative hearings and due process. *See* Ark. Code Ann. § 12-18-801 et seq.
