 help identify and train active and effective youth and adult leaders for community, county and statewide leadership roles.


Public Policy



- Educate the general public on local government issues


Why Rural Development / Local Government Programs?






Employment Change 2010 to 2016

Population Change 2012 to 2017














Property Assessments Change 1999 to 2017





Property Assessment Change 2009 to 2017






