3	REQUESTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON INSURANCE AND COMMERCE TO
4	STUDY AN INCREASE OF THE MINIMUM MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY
5	INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

7	WHEREAS, in Arkansas, an individual who operates a motor vehicle is
8	required to have minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage for the
9	individual operating the motor vehicle; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage amounts
12	were established in 1999; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage in
15	Arkansas includes:
16	(1) Not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for
17	bodily injury or death of one (1) person in any one (1) accident;
18	(2) Not less than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for bodily
19	injury or death of two (2) or more persons in any one (1) accident; and
20	(3) Not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for
21	damage to or destruction of property of others in any one (1) accident; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage amounts
24	have not been increased in twenty-four (24) years; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, four (4) of the surrounding states have the same minimum motor
27	vehicle liability insurance coverage amounts; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, Louisiana has lower or matching minimum motor vehicle
30	liability insurance coverage amounts than Arkansas of fifteen thousand
31	dollars (\$15,000) for bodily injury or death of one (1) person in any one (1)
32	accident, thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for bodily injury or death of two
33	(2) or more persons in any one (1) accident, and twenty-five thousand dollars
34	(\$25,000) for damage to or destruction of property of others in any one (1)
35	accident; and

WHEREAS, Texas has higher minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage amounts than Arkansas of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for bodily injury or death of one (1) person in any one (1) accident, sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for bodily injury or death of two (2) or more persons in any one (1) accident, and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for damage to or destruction of property of others in any one (1) accident, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON INSURANCE AND COMMERCE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY: THAT the Senate Committee on Insurance and Commerce conduct a study to: (1) Identify the needs and costs associated with increasing the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance requirements; (2) Identify the concerns related to increasing the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance requirements; (3) Determine the impact on insurance premium rates for an average Arkansas driver if the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance requirements are increased; and (4) Determine the appropriate amount of increase for the minimum motor vehicle liability insurance requirements.
