## 8.5 Fidelity and honest dealing.

(a) In accepting employment as an agent, a licensee pledges to protect and promote the interests of the client or clients. This obligation of absolute fidelity to the interest of the client or clients is primary, but does not relieve a licensee from the equally binding obligation of dealing honestly with all parties to the transaction. (b) A licensee shall not offer or advertise property without authority and in any offering or advertisement the price quoted must not be other than that agreed upon with the owners as the offering price. (c) When acting as agent in the sale or management of property, a licensee shall not accept any commission, rebate, profit, payment, compensation or other valuable consideration from any source in connection with the property without full written disclosure to the party represented by the licensee. (d) A licensee shall not accept compensation from more than one party without full written disclosure to all parties to the transaction.
