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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 79, is amended to add an

34	The General Assembly finds that:
35	(1) Pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome, also
36	known as "PANS", is a clinically defined disorder characterized by the



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1	sudden onset of obsessive-compulsive symptoms or eating restrictions,
2	accompanied by two (2) or more symptoms of acute behavioral
3	deterioration or motor and sensory changes, or both;
4	(2) Pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorder
5	associated with streptococcal infections, also known as "PANDAS", is a
6	term used to describe a subset of children and adolescents within the
7	broader PANS classification;
8	(3) Some insurance companies are currently providing
9	disparate insurance coverage for the treatment of PANS and PANDAS,
10	including the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance

14	coverage purposes.
15	(d) The interdisciplinary team shall report to the Senate
16	Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor, the House Committee on
17	Public Health, Welfare and Labor, the Senate Committee on Insurance
18	and Commerce, and the House Committee on Insurance and Commerce no
19	later than August 31, 2019.
20	(e) Once the interdisciplinary team determines appropriate
21	diagnostic criteria for the protocol, a final report with
22	recommendations shall be submitted to the Senate Committee on Public
23	Health, Welfare and Labor, the House Committee on Public Health,
24	Welfare and Labor, the Senate Committee on Insurance and Commerce, the
25	House Committee on Insurance and Commerce, and the General Assembly to
26	include recommendations concerning mandating insurance coverage for

4	shall provide coverage for the treatment of PANS and PANDAS diagnosed
5	according to the established diagnostic criteria recommended by the
6	<u>interdisciplinary team.</u>
7	(g) The goal of the interdisciplinary team is to have that the
8	diagnostic criteria shall be finalized and ready to be presented at
9	the December 2019 meeting of the Senate Committee on Public Health,
10	Welfare and Labor, the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare and
11	Labor, the Senate Committee on Insurance and Commerce, and the House
12	<u>Committee on Insurance and Commerce.</u>
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14	SECTION 2. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Arkansas PANS/PANDAS</u>
15	<u>Advisory Council — Creation — Duties.</u>
16	(a) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council is created.
17	(b) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall be composed of the
18	following members:
19	(1) Two (2) members of the House of Representatives appointed by
20	the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
21	(2) Two (2) members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro
22	<u>Tempore of the Senate;</u>
23	(3) One (1) member who is a medical professional with two (2)
24	years of professional experience working with PANS/PANDAS patients, appointed
25	by the Governor;
26	(4) One (1) member who is a medical professional with two (2)
27	years of professional experience working with PANS/PANDAS patients, appointed
28	by the Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council;
29	(5) The Director of the Department of Health or his or her
30	<u>designee, serving as an ex officio nonvoting member;</u>
31	(6) The Insurance Commissioner or his or her designee, serving
32	<u>as an ex officio nonvoting member;</u>
33	(7) Three (3) members who are employed by a public school
34	district appointed by the Governor, one (1) member to be a public school
35	nurse, one (1) member to be a public school counselor, and one (1) member to
36	<u>be a public school teacher;</u>

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1	(8) One (1) member who is designated by the Arkansas Hospital
2	Association, Inc.;
3	(9) One (1) member who is designated by the Arkansas State Board
4	<u>of Nursing;</u>
5	(10) One (1) member who is designated by the Arkansas
6	Pharmacist's Association;
7	(11) One (1) member who is designated by the American Academy of
8	Allergy, Asthma, and Immunology;
9	(12) Two (2) members who are parents, appointed by the Governor;
10	and
11	(13) One (1) member who is designated by the Arkansas Medical,
12	Dental, and Pharmaceutical Association, Inc.
13	(c) The terms of the members of the Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory
14	Council shall expire on December 31, 2020.
15	(d) Members shall serve at the pleasure of the organizations they
16	represent or of the Governor, as indicated.
17	(e) Vacancies on the Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall be
18	filled in the same manner as provided for the initial appointment.
19	(f) The chair and vice-chair of the Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory
20	Council shall be one (1) of the legislative members of the interdisciplinary
21	panel and shall be selected by the members of the interdisciplinary panel.
22	(g) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall meet as often as
23	is deemed necessary by the chair.
24	(h) All members of the Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall
25	serve without compensation and shall not receive per diem, mileage, or
26	stipends.
27	(i) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall receive staff
28	support from the Bureau of Legislative Research.
29	(j) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council may:
30	(1) Make recommendations designed to improve and increase
31	knowledge and develop mechanisms to increase clinical awareness and treatment
32	throughout the state for pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome,
33	also known as "PANS", and pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders
34	associated with streptococcal infection, also known as "PANDAS", especially
35	for healthcare professionals;
36	(2) Operate along with the interdisciplinary panel at the

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1	University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to determine quarterly
2	information, including case statistics, outcome measures, and other relevant
3	information;
4	(3) Make recommendations concerning standard practice guidelines
5	for the diagnosis and treatment of PANS/PANDAS;
6	(4) Provide outreach to educators and parents; and
7	(5) Develop a network of volunteer experts on PANS/PANDAS to
8	serve as resources within this state.
9	(k)(1) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall submit a report
10	to the Legislative Council, the Senate Committee on Insurance and Commerce,
11	the House Committee on Insurance and Commerce, the Senate Committee on Public
12	Health, Welfare, and Labor, and the House Committee on Public Health,
13	Welfare, and Labor no later than August 31, 2019.
14	(2) The Arkansas PANS/PANDAS Advisory Council shall report to
15	the Senate Committee on Insurance and Commerce, the House Committee on
16	Insurance and Commerce, the Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and
17	Labor, and the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor as
18	requested.
