Resolution on the Joint Interim Committee on Energy REQUESTING THAT THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON ENERGY SUPPORT THE EFFORTS OF CONGRESSMEN RICK CRAWFORD, FRENCH HILL, BRUCE WESTERMAN, AND STEVE WOMACK TO LIFT THE BAN ON THE EXPORT OF CRUDE OIL AS A MEANS BY WHICH TO GROW OUR ECONOMY, STRENGTHEN OUR POSITION AS A GLOBAL LEADER, AND FURTHER OUR NATIONAL SECURITY.
