


<u>At-Risk Students</u>

<u>A major Challenge in Education is students are</u> <u>struggling with:</u>

- attendance, behavioral and academic concerns.
- They are dealing with language barriers, disproportionality and discrimination.
- Students are disengaging mentally, physically and emotionally at an alarming rate.
- Violent acts on self, students and/or staff.
- Graduating students are often not prepared for college or career.

<u>Problem</u>: Student Data is not accessible when you need it!


Educators said: "Bottom line, we don't know who is At-Risk at any given time."

- which is not working with our goal of graduating students ready for college and career (CCR).






