Attorney Ad Litem Training Initial Qualification and Ongoing Requirements

The AR Supreme Court requires that all attorneys appointed to represent children complete not less than 10 hours of initial qualification training and complete a clinical component where the attorney must participate in each type of hearing with an appointed attorney ad litem. To remain qualified, the attorney must maintain at least four additional hours each year. The Attorney Ad Litem

Program requires all attorneys employed or contracted with the program to attend the Children in the Courts Conference and a Fall Conference each year. The AAL Program offers approximately 40 hours of continued legal education annually. There are many opportunities for joint training with CASA and other child welfare professionals.

The Arkansas AAL Program has been nationally recognized for their development and implementation of a comprehensive children's attorney evaluation protocol

One half of the AALs have been with the program for more than 10 years

Key Responsibilities of the DN AAL

- Provide Independent Legal Advocacy for Child's Best Interest
- Maintain Ongoing Contact with Client and/or their Caregiver's
- Conduct Independent Investigation May be done in Conjunction with CASA
 - Actively Participate in all Hearings
 - Earnest Efforts to Attend all Case Plan Staffings and Mediations
 - Provide all Relevant Information to the Court
 - Inform Court of Child's Wishes if Different from AAL Recommendations
 - Explain Court Proceedings and Attorney Role to Client
 - Assist Client in Understanding their Legal Rights
 - Advocate for Case Specific Services for the Child & Family
- Monitor Implementation of the Case Plans and Court Orders and Case Progress
 - File Appropriate Pleadings
 - Advocate for Timely Hearings without Unnecessary Delays
 - Advocate for Speedy Permanency for the Child
 - Request Orders that are Clear, Specific, and Include Timelines
 - Advocate for CASA Volunteer to be Appointed
 - Ensure CASA Report is Introduced into Court Record



<u>Arkansas CASA – A Statewide Program of Advocacy for Abused and Neglected</u> <u>Children</u>

During FY 2015, 3,768 youth in foster care had a relentless volunteer advocate at their side thanks to 1,325 CASA volunteers. All twenty-five local CASA programs across Arkansas are united in their mission to provide quality advocacy for abused and neglected children in the court system and adhere to comprehensive program standards. Volunteers undergo thorough background checks and complete a minimum of thirty hours of training prior to working with any child.

A SOLUTION THAT WORKS-THE COURT APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATE PROGRAM

Better Outcomes Proven for Children

- Low CASA caseloads mean the courts can make better decisions for children. CASA volunteers handle just 1 or 2 cases at a time, so that they can give each child's case the sustained, personal attention he or she deserves.¹
- Children with CASA volunteers spent 7.5 months less in foster care, experience fewer out-of-home placements and have significantly improved educational performance.ⁱⁱ

Cost Effectiveness

- During 2013, Arkansas CASA volunteers donated 132,385 hours, valued at \$3,706,178 to support youth in foster care.ⁱⁱⁱ
- 75 to 1 return on investment. Funding for one staff supervisory position within a local CASA program supports 30 trained volunteer advocates, assigned to 75+ children's cases within a year.^{iv}
