the Purchase Order between CoCentrix and DHS

Purchaser: The Department of Human Services (hereafter "DHS")

Vendor: CoCentrix, Inc.

Time of Validity: October 14, 2013 to June 30, 2014

Purpose of Contract: "To provide Arkansas and DHS-Division of Medical Services with a web-based interRAI CMH assessment instrument software application per:

- CoCentrix Pilot Project Performance Indicators;
- AR DHS 4001 Business Associate Agreement:
- CoCentrix Budget FY2014;
- CoCentrix Employment Practices;
- DMS Clean Copy Arkansas BH Pilot Test;
- DMS Requirements for Behavioral Health Pilot testing Dated August 30, 2013"

Payment Terms: \$65,625.00

Payment will be made after commodities or services are delivered, accepted, received, and invoiced. A payment will not be made prior to the delivery of commodities or services.

Any billings for services rendered during a state fiscal year that are submitted within ninety (90) days of the end of fiscal year will not be paid.

If the contract is terminated, payment for partially completed services or deliverables satisfactorily delivered to and not yet approved by DHS shall be a price mutually agreed upon by CoCentrix and DHS.

Obligations of Vendor:

CoCentrix shall:

- Comply with all DHS policies governing privacy and security of confidential information;
- 2. Implement and maintain reasonable security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of the confidential information;
- 3. Comply with the Business Associate Agreement;
- 4. Disclose any breaches of privacy or security by contacting the Information Technology Security Officer within one (1) business day of the breach;
- 5. Ensure that its product comply with the state's Shared Technical Architecture Program
- 6. Not discriminate against any qualified employee or qualified applicant for employment because of race, color, creed, national origin, or ancestry and include a similar provision binding upon all subcontractors;
- 7. Be fully responsible for all work performed under the contract;
- 8. Pay all expenses of legal action to enforce any provision of the contract including attorney's fees and costs at all stages of litigation;
- 9. Grant access to its records upon request by state or federal government entities or any of their duly authorized representatives;
- 10. Ensure the information technology meets certain statutory requirements relating accessibility by person with visual impairments:
- 11. Submit to the state all outstanding claims within ten (10) working days after the receipt of a notice of termination;
- 12. Retain all records for five (5) years (or six (6) years for protected healthcare information) after final payment is made under the contract or any related subcontract; and
- 13. Comply with state audit requirements as outlined in the Arkansas State of Human Services Audit Guidelines.

CoCentrix may:

1. Enter into written subcontracts for performance of certain functions under the contract, upon prior written consent of DHS

Obligations of Purchaser:

DHS shall:

- Submit the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Policy of CoCentrix to the Office of State Procurement who will maintain a file of all vendor EEO policies received;
- 2. Have the right to enter the contractor's work areas to inspect, monitor, or otherwise evaluate the quality, appropriateness, and timeliness of work, services, or both, that have been or are being performed; and
- 3. Have the right to set-off any money that CoCentrix owes DHS from the payment by DHS to CoCentrix under the contract.

DHS may:

- 1. Cancel the contract to the extent that funds are no longer legally available for expenditures under this contract;
- 2. Cancel the contract unilaterally at any time for any reason by giving the other party thirty (30) calendar days written notice, and delivering notice of cancellation either in person or by certified mail, return receipt requested, restricted delivery; and
- 3. Cancel the contract in whole or in part when DHS determines that CoCentrix or its subcontractor has failed to satisfactorily perform its contractual duties and responsibilities.

Purpose of Amendment: Amends the License Agreement with regards to the payment terms and the fees established in Schedule I

Specifically, the following terms and/or fees have been amended:

- 1. The Licensing fee for CoCentrix CCP Provider Access licenses was increased to \$65 and the license quantity was reduced to 20,000:
- 2. The additional user fees were modified; and
- 3. The support and maintenance service fees were reduced.

The highlighted portions within the Payment Terms show the amendments.

- 2. Have the right to electronically audit the number of Licensed Users accessing the Licensed Program;
- 3. Provide support and maintenance as follows:

- a. DHS shall pay for the Support Services fees;
- CoCentrix shall provide periodic releases of the Licensed Programs to include enhancements, corrections, and/or state and national regulatory changes; and
- c. Other support services:
 - i. Software support for processing of reported concerns, diagnosis, and resolution of defective application functionality for licensed software;
 - ii. Written notification of availability of software updates and/or new releases;
 - iii. Support for installation of upgrades and new releases;
 - iv. DHS Support available for guidance on published software materials and intended use of licensed software;
 - v. In the instance that DHS reports a software defect for a software version that was released greater than three months prior, consider required changes to the most recent publicly available or future version;
 - vi. Programming and modification/updates of billing components as required by Third Party payers; and
 - vii. Telephone support services as needed; and
- 4. .Defend or settle any claim, suit, or proceeding brought against DHS regarding infringement, patent, copyright, trademark service, registered design, or application for the above in connection with the supply, installation, training, or use of the whole or any part of the Licensed Programs and indemnify and hold DHS harmless against all coast and damages incurred by DHS.

CoCentrix may:

- Terminate the agreement after delivery of written notice to DHS without further obligations or liability if DHS fails to make payment of any undisputed invoice past due more than sixty (60) days; and
- 2. Terminate the agreement in the event of a default by DHS in the performance of any material obligation under the agreement or a material breach by DHS of any provision that is not cured within thirty (30) days after delivery of written notice.

Obligations of Purchaser:

DHS shall:

- 1. Access the Licensed Programs and Materials within the number of Licensed Users:
- 2. Use the Licensed Program and Licensed Materials only for its internal use and within the scope of operations;
- 3. Comply with the proprietary rights of CoCentrix;
- 4. Make copies of those portions of the Licensed Programs and Materials provided strictly for the internal use of DHS;
- 5. Not:

- a. De-compile, disassemble, or otherwise reverse engineer all or any part of the Licensed Program;
- b. Create, produce, market, license to others, or sell to others any product that competes with the Licensed Programs; or
- c. Permit any other person to do the above;
- 6. Execute and deliver any other agreement that a Third Party may require;
- 7. Meet requirements for Cloud Services:
 - a. Designate a single Liaison Officer;
 - b. Be responsible for the computing environment;
 - c. Procure all equipment, software, network and internet access and take all necessary actions to access the Licensed Programs and the Data Center, provide information to CoCentrix, and ensure security and privacy;
 - d. Comply with all security standards, practices, and procedures established by CoCentrix in connection with the use of the related software;
 - e. Be responsible for the equipment, installation, and monthly costs of DHS's network and Internet connection to the Data Center;
 - f. Provide a list of users and the level of security of the users; and
 - g. Be responsible for all acts and omissions of the authorized users, unauthorized users;
- 8. Require that its End Users accept and agree to the terms of the End User License Agreement to access and use the InterRAI content; and
- 9. Either return all copies of the Licensed Programs and Materials or destroy all copies of the Licensed Programs and Materials within ten (10) days after the termination of this agreement.

DHS may:

- Terminate the agreement without cause at any time upon written notice to CoCentrix specifying a termination date no earlier than thirty (30) days from the date of the written notice; and
- 2. Immediately terminate the agreement upon giving written notice of termination to CoCentrix if CoCentrix ceases its business operations.
