The local agency has the option of conducting the investigation independently or jointly with CACD, or declining involvement at that point. If local authorities decline to investigate and if the CACD investigator finds sufficient information to suspect that a serious crime has occurred, the investigator shall contact the State Police Criminal Investigation Division (CID) and request that a criminal investigation be conducted.



The decision to actually charge criminally is made using a beyond a reasonable doubt standard; an evaluation which requires significantly more probative evidence than any other standard of proof used in the law.
