Consideration to Adopt November 17, 2021, Meeting Minutes [Exhibit B]

Senator English made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Representative Brown, and the motion carried.

Presentation of Cybersecurity Practices at Next Step Innovation [Exhibit C]

Trent Townsend, CEO, Next Step Innovation, and Dr. David O'Gwynn, Director of Cybersecurity, Next Step Innovation, gave a presentation on best practices of cybersecurity, including information on better security for schools and state organizations.

Presentation of the Department of Information Systems (DIS) Activities [Exhibit D]

Jonathan Askins, Director DIS, Transportation and Shared Services, gave a presentation on inprogress projects, including standards for those projects and timelines for completion.
