

- Bridging & scheduling services had been outsourced for last 17 years.
 - With last contract ending a working group of various users looked at the services needed and cost/flexibility to provide.
 - Most cost effective and future proof arrangement was to have DIS provide the services.
 - Cutover was completed during the Spring Break week.

Current Video Network

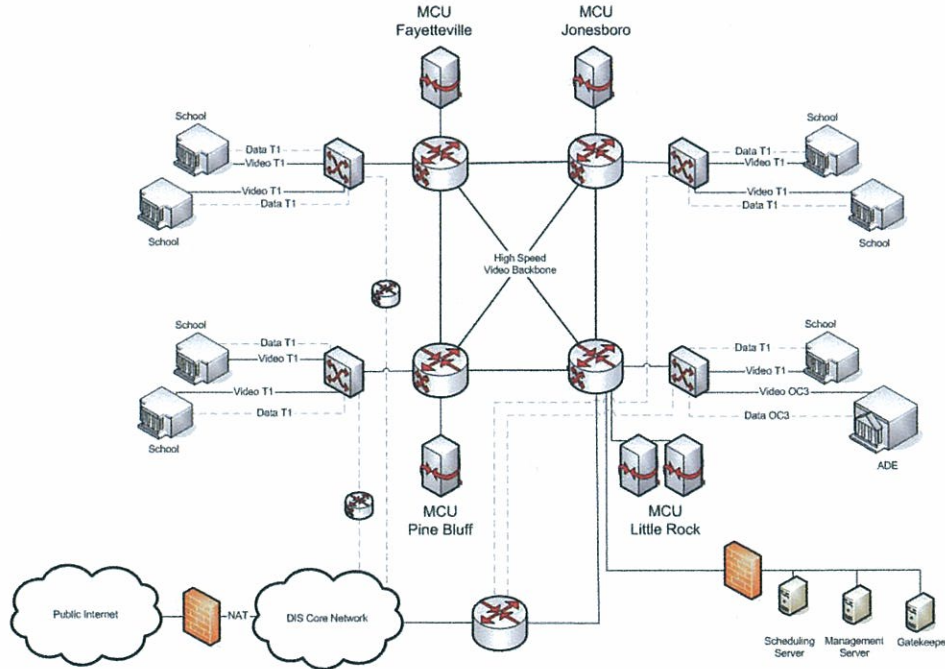
- Bridged H.323 room Systems
- Support for H.239 content streams (sharing content in HD)
- Video streaming, capture, and storage
- Support for desktop video conferencing (Lync compatibility)
- Support for Real Presence mobile video conferencing (iOS or Android)

Current Video Network Average Usage

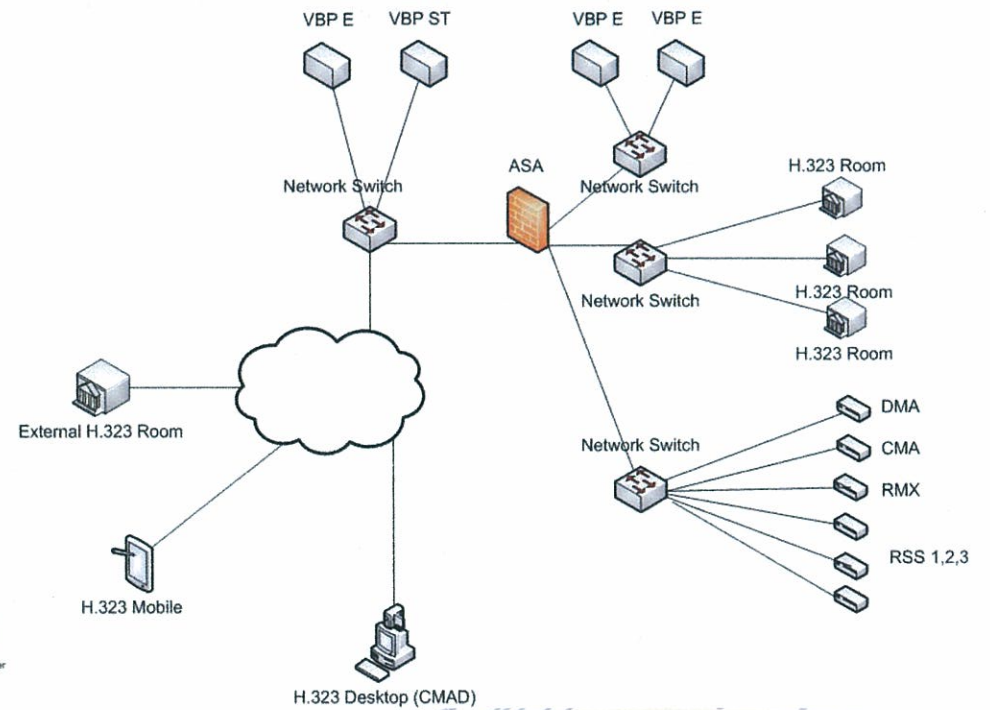
- Number of Registered Systems: 511
 - Average Conferences Per Week: 1,810
