About the Information Network of Arkansas

The Information Network of Arkansas is a public-private partnership formed by legislation in 1995. Arkansas code \$25-27-101 establishes INA's mission to expand access to government services and information for citizens and businesses in Arkansas.

Since 1997, INA has developed and supports the ongoing operation of over 700 websites and online services on behalf of 116 Arkansas state government agencies, boards and commissions as well as 103 city and county government entities. Thousands of citizens use its services each year to process over 7 million secure online transactions.

Although INA is primarily funded through fees paid by citizens and businesses who choose to use its value added services, over 60% of services developed and supported by INA do not involve transaction fees.

The contract for management of these services was awarded to the Arkansas Information Consortium, LLC., a subsidiary of NIC, Inc., through a competitive bid process in 1997 and again in 2011. INA's twelve-member board, whose members are appointed by the Governor, is comprised of both public and private sector representatives of key government and business interests and approves all fees charged for these services.
