Please consider this memorandum to be our request to be placed on agendas for the Rules and Regulations Committee and the Public Health Committee.

In compliance with Arkansas statutes and following the passage of Act 604 of the 2013 Legislative Session, mark-up copies of the proposed changes to the Board of Nursing Rules – Chapter 4-Advanced Practice Nursing, have been provided. Our public comment period ended July 31, 2013. A summary of the public comments is attached hereto.

In an effort to align with the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) APRN Consensus Mode, the Arkansas State Board of Nursing (ASBN) initiated legislative updates to the Nurse Practice Act and Chapter 4 Rules.

Proposed Changes to ASBN Rules August 1, 2013 Page 2

Synopsis of Rules Changes for Chapter 4:

- The title of Advanced Practice Nurse (APN) will change to Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN).
- One of the four APN roles will also have a title change. The title of Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP) will change to Certified Nurse Practitioner (CNP).
- The Prescriptive Authority Advisory Committee will gain an additional APRN member that is not required to hold Prescriptive Authority. This will allow APRNs such as CRNAs and APRN-licensed Nurse Educators to sit on the committee.

There is no expected opposition to the proposed changes to the ASBN *Rules*. No financial impact is anticipated. Copies of the Financial Impact forms and questionnaire were previously provided. The public comment period began on July 1, 2013 and ended July 31, 2013. The public hearings were held. Provided no changes are needed, the *Rules* changes in Chapter 4 are set to be effective on October 1, 2013.
