SUBJECT: Arkansas Long Term Care Facility Nursing Assistant Training Program

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: Current regulations require that instructors in Certified Nurse Aide training programs be nurses licensed by the State of Arkansas. However, some training programs that are located near the state border have difficulty filling positions. Arkansas is a member of a compact with other states that permits nurses in those compact states to practice nursing in Arkansas. The amendment to the regulations will also permit those individuals to act as instructors in Certified Nurse Aide training programs in Arkansas.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No public hearing was held. The public comment period expired on January 1, 2016. The Department received no comments.

The proposed effective date is pending Legislative approval.

CONTROVERSY: This rule change does not have a financial impact because it allows nurses that are licensed in other states to be nurse aide training program instructors.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: There is no financial impact.

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION: Arkansas Code Annotated § 20-10-705 specifically authorizes the Office of Long-Term Care to "promulgate regulations necessary to implement an aide training program for all long-term care facilities in this state, to prescribe in-service training programs, and to enforce compliance with those programs."
