SUBJECT: EPISODE 1-15 and Section 1 3-15

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: Effective July 1, 2016, the Episodes of Care Provider Manual is updated to clarify the definitions and scope of services and current requirements to be designated as a Principal Accountable Provider. The existing exclusions and quality measures for Episodes of Care are also clarified.

<u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u>: A public hearing was held on March 25, 2016. The public comment period expired on April 5, 2016. The department received no comments.

The proposed effective date is July 1, 2016.

CONTROVERSY: This rule may be controversial. While the episode based payment improvement initiative does not change current reimbursement, there is risk that providers could incur a negative incentive adjustment that would require them to remit money back to Medicaid.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: There is no financial impact.

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION: The Department has general rule making authority pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 20-76-201 (12), stating that he Department has the authority to make necessary rules and regulations to administer its various programs.
