201.010	A new section is being added which replicates the transition plan that was previously promulgated as part of the ARChoices waiver. This plan describes the transition of individuals from ElderChoices and Alternatives for Adults with Physical Disabilities to ARChoices in Homecare during 2016.
201.105	Language added to clarify that providers must attend at least one training per year.
212.000 F.	Corrects language describing when the eligibility begin date starts, so that it matches other policies.
212.300 C.	Clarified how Attendant Care hours are authorized.
212.324	Section on Hospice deleted as it does not apply to ARChoices.
Various	Changed references to one hour billing units to 15 minute billing units throughout, so that it matches current practice.
213.290	clarified current practices concerning billing for Environmental Modifications/Adaptive Equipment.
