ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE MANUAL UPDATE 2016-01 SUMMARY

The purpose of the proposed rule is update the Rules of Practice and Procedure to coincide with requirements in the Division of Behavioral Health Services (DBHS) Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Comprehensive Substance Abuse Services.

This update is necessary so that the language in the Rules of Practice and Procedure manual for organizations funded by the DBHS mirrors language in the RFQ for Comprehensive Substance Abuse Services. The RFQ instructs respondents to refer to the DBHS Rules of Practice and Procedure manual so it is necessary that the language is consistent.

The proposed amendment clarifies that providers will receive payment from DBHS for necessary services billed to DBHS provided to individuals whose income is at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level as issued in the Federal Register by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

The proposed amendment also updates service definitions as well as updates Prevention Provider staff requirements to receive funding from DBHS to better align with best practices and national standards.
