3	of a physician;
4	(4)(2)(A) "Athletic training" means the prevention, recognition,
5	evaluation, treatment, and rehabilitation of an athletic injury or illness
6	and the organization and administration of exercise, conditioning, and
7	athletic training programs practice by athletic trainers to optimize the
8	activity and participation of patients and clients through prevention,
9	diagnosis, and intervention of emergency medical conditions, acute medical
10	conditions, and chronic medical conditions involving impairment, functional
11	limitations, and disabilities.
12	(B) The scope of practice for athletic trainers shall be
13	established by rule of the Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training based
14	upon current educational standards and guidelines of the athletic trainers'
15	alliance of approved credentialing and accreditation agencies; and
16	(5) "Board" means the Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training;
17	(6) "Direct supervision" means supervision of the athletic
18	trainer in a clinical setting in which the supervising physical therapist
19	must be readily available for consultation for the care of the athlete but
20	not necessarily on the premises;
21	(7)(3) "License" means the document issued by the board to a
22	qualified person to practice athletic training; and
23	(8) "Sanctioned recreational sports activities" means any
24	athletic or team activity which requires physical strength, agility,
25	flexibility, range of motion, speed, or stamina and meets one (1) or more of
26	the following:
27	(A) Has officially designated coaches who have the
28	responsibility for athletic activities of the organization;
29	(B) Has a regular schedule of practices or workouts which
30	are supervised by the officially designated coaches;
31	(C) Is an activity generally recognized as having an
32	established schedule of competitive events or exhibitions; and
33	(D) Has a policy requiring documentation of having passed
34	a preparticipation medical examination conducted by a licensed physician as a
35	condition for participation for the athletic activities of the organization.
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1	17-93-403. Penalties.
2	(a) (1) Any person who violates a provision of this subchapter is
3	guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred
4	dollars (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment
5	for not less than thirty (30) days nor more than one hundred eighty (180)
6	days, or both.
7	(2) Each day of a violation constitutes a separate offense.
8	(b)(1) After notice and hearing, the Arkansas State Board of Athletic
9	Training is also authorized to may levy a civil penalty against any:
10	(A) person Person licensed under the provisions of this
11	subchapter after a finding that the person has violated any of the provisions
12	of this subchapter or any regulations rule promulgated by the board; and
13	(B) Unlicensed person practicing or offering to practice
14	any actions requiring licensure pursuant to the provisions of this
15	subchapter.
16	(2) Each day of a violation constitutes a separate offense.
17	(c) Givil penalties A civil penalty assessed by the board shall be no
18	more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per incident.
19	(d) In addition to any other sanctions authorized by this subchapter,
20	the board may impose a civil penalty as provided in this section against any
21	unlicensed person practicing or offering to practice any actions requiring
22	licensure pursuant to the provisions of this subchapter.
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24	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-93-406 is amended to read as follows:
25	17-93-406. Powers and duties of the board.
26	(a) The Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training shall have the
27	following powers and duties <u>to</u> :
28	(1) To receive Receive and maintain all records of board
29	proceedings;
30	(2) To adopt Adopt minimum curriculum and internship
31	requirements for qualification for an Arkansas athletic trainer's license;
32	(3) To issue Issue licenses;
33	(4) To keep Keep a complete record of all licensed athletic
34	trainers, including:
35	(A) Preparing annually a roster showing the names and
36	addresses of all licensed athletic trainers; and

1	(B) Making available a copy of such a roster to any person
2	requesting it on payment of a fee as established by the board to cover the
3	cost of the roster;
4	(5) To adopt Adopt rules and regulations consistent with this
5	subchapter which are necessary for the performance of its duties, including,
6	but not limited to, the imposing of fees adequate to carry out the purposes
7	of this subchapter;
8	(6) To collect Collect fees adequate to carry out the purposes
9	of this subchapter;
10	(7) To keep Keep records of fees collected and costs incurred
11	for operations of the board and licensing of athletic trainers; and
12	(8) To file $\underline{\text{File}}$ an annual report of its activities, including
13	the activities of the board, with the Department of Finance and
14	Administration.
15	(b) In addition to the powers and duties set forth in this subchapter,
16	the board shall investigate reported violations of this subchapter and take
17	necessary steps to enforce this subchapter.
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19	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code §§ $17-93-409-17-93-413$ are amended to read
20	as follows:
21	17-93-409. Qualification — Athletic trainer.
22	(a) For the purpose of this subchapter, a person is actively engaged
23	as an athletic trainer if the person has performed such duties as a principal
24	part of his or her full-time employment under the direction of a licensed
25	physician for three (3) of the past five (5) years preceding the application.
26	$\frac{(b)(a)}{(b)}$ An applicant for an Arkansas athletic trainer's license must is
27	required to:
28	(1) Possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or
29	university;
30	(2) Meet other minimum athletic training curriculum and
31	internship requirements as specified established by the Arkansas State Board
32	of Athletic Training;
33	(3) Pass an examination for licensure as designated by the board
34	which is a reliable, valid, legally defensible examination for determining
35	minimum competency in athletic training;
36	(4) Submit appropriate application forms to the board; and

1	(5) Pay all appropriate fees.
2	(c) Notarized proof of employment, performance of duties, and
3	supervision shall accompany the person's application.
4	(d)(b) Anyone A person who meets the qualifications prescribed in
5	subsection (b) (a) of this section, except for the examination requirement
6	under subdivision $\frac{b}{3}$ $\frac{a}{3}$ of this section, shall be issued a temporary
7	nonrenewable athletic trainer's permit license which shall expire one (1)
8	year after the date of application therefor.
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10	17-93-410. Expiration and renewal.
11	(a) A license issued under this subchapter expires one (1) year after
12	the date of issuance on June 30th of each calendar year.
13	(b)(1) Licenses A license shall be renewed according to procedures
l 4	established by the Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training.
1.5	(2) The board shall renew a license upon proof of
16	recertification as a certified athletic trainer provided by the athletic
17	trainers' national governing entity which shall include:
18	(A) Compliance with the standard of professional practice;
19	(B) Emergency cardiac care certification;
20	(C) Maintenance of fees; and
21	(D) Successful completion of continuing education
22	requirements as determined by the board.
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24	17-93-411. Direction and supervision Physician direction.
25	(a) In a nonclinical setting, an \underline{An} athletic trainer may practice the
26	art and science of athletic training only under the direction of a physician
27	licensed in the State of Arkansas.
28	(b) The athletic trainer may practice athletic training in a hospital
29	or outpatient clinic under the direct supervision of a physical therapist and
30	upon the referral of a physician licensed in the State of Arkansas. \checkmark
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32	17-93-412. Revocation, suspension, or denial - Grounds.
33	(a) The Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training may refuse to issue
34	or renew a license or $\underline{\text{may}}$ suspend or revoke a license if an applicant $\underline{\text{or}}$
35	<u>licensee</u> has:
36	(1) Been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor involving moral

1	turpitude, the record of conviction being conclusive evidence of conviction
2	if the board determines after investigation that the person has not been
3	sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust;
4	(2) Secured a license under this subchapter by fraud or deceit;
5	or
6	(3) Violated or conspired to violate this subchapter or rules or
7	regulations issued pursuant to under this subchapter;
8	(4) Been found guilty of unethical or unprofessional conduct, as
9	determined by the board;
10	(5) Been convicted of a violation of any state or federal
11	narcotics laws;
12	(6) Been habitually intoxicated or has been addicted to the use
13	of narcotic drugs;
14	(7) Been found guilty of gross negligence in his or her
15	practice, as determined by the board;
16	(8) Been convicted of sexual abuse or sexual misconduct; or
17	(9) Been declared incompetent by a court and has not thereafter
18	been lawfully declared competent.
19	(b)(l) On application, the board may reissue a license to a person
20	whose license has been revoked, but the application may not be made $\frac{1}{2}$
21	before the expiration of a period of one (1) year after the order of
22	revocation has become final.
23	(2) Such $\underline{\text{The}}$ application shall be made in the manner and form
24	required by the board.
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26	17-93-413. Revocation, suspension, or denial - Proceedings.
27	(a) Any person whose application for a license or for renewal of a
28	license is denied is entitled to a hearing, which shall be conducted pursuant
29	to under the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.
30	(b)(1) Proceedings for revocation or suspension of a license shall be
31	commenced by filing charges with the Arkansas State Board of Athletic
32	Training in writing.
33	(2) The charge may be brought by any person against a person
34	having a license to practice as an athletic trainer in this state charging
35	that the person has committed a violation under § 17-93-412.
36	(3)(A) The board shall send an advisory notice to the person who

13	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 93, Subchapter 4, is
14	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
15	17-93-415. Notice of malpractice claim or suit.
16	(a) An athletic trainer shall notify the Arkansas State Board of
17	Athletic Training within ten (10) days after receipt of notification or a
18	claim or a lawsuit against the athletic trainer for malpractice.
19	(b) The board shall prepare and adopt rules as necessary and proper to
20	ensure compliance with this section.
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
