COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS & TRAINING

SUBJECT: Regulation 1016; Certification of Civil Traffic Wardens

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>: This rule allows civilians to file parking violations and traffic accident reports, freeing up uniformed policy in first class cities. Qualified individuals will be certified for issuing citations for parks violations occurring within the corporate limits of a municipality of first class and for preparing traffic accident reports and, in connection with any such reporting, issuing any necessary traffic citations.

PUBLIC COMMENT: The commission held a public hearing on October 14, 2010 and did not receive any public comments. The commission verified that while the authorizing statute has been in place since 1995, this rule reflects the implementation of the program. The commission noted that the program has been in effect in Little Rock for some time since the legislation was passed.

The proposed effective date was October 14, 2010.

CONTROVERSY: This is not expected to be controversial.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: There is no financial impact.

LEGAL AUTHORIZATION: The rule implements Act 137 of 2007 and § 12-9-110, which requires person performing law enforcement duties under that section to meet minimum standards prescribed by the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the exercise of that authority.
