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
# 2012 Medicaid Mapping Project

## Distribution of Medicaid Clients in Arkansas

777,315 Medicaid records were processed representing claims during the 2012 State Fiscal Year.

761,840 records were mapped in Arkansas. Those records were associated with the corresponding legislative district.

13,468 records were outside Arkansas. It is common for an out of state family member to manage the finances of an elderly family member.


2,007 records could not be located. The address information was not sufficient to map.

Medicaid clients.



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
# Percentage of Senate District Population Medicaid Clients


2012 Medicaid Client Payments by Senate District



Total Medicaid expenditure exceeds \$3.7 Billion. 30% of the cost is born by the state.


The average Senate District received \$99 million in claims.


