## Arkansas Swine Regulations Summary of Changes May 20, 2013

### Page 1. Definitions

Feral or Wild Swine: Added: Also, a hog that is not conspicuously identified.  
(From Act 1104 of 2013)

Added new definition from Act 1104 of 2013: Terminal Facility: A facility for the containment of domestic and feral hogs that requires that the hog be killed before leaving the facility.

### Page 4. Part C. Feral Swine

~~Until they have become domesticated~~ was deleted because Act 1104 of 2013 does not allow domestication of feral swine.

### Page 7 through Page 12. Feral Swine.

The entire section of Feral Swine was deleted because Act 1104 of 2013 made that section obsolete. A whole new section on Feral Swine was added to comply with the Act.

**Page 7.** 1) The Act defines “Feral Hogs” and regulates the capturing, killing, and transporting of feral hogs.

**Page 8.** The new narrative describes terminal facilities and how the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission will regulate those facilities.

**Page 8 and 9.** Part i.) Describes the fencing requirements for terminal facilities.

**Page 9.** Part ii.) Describes the operation of terminal facilities under Commission regulations.

**Page 9.** Part iii.) Describes the inspection and licensing of terminal facilities.

**Page 9 and 10.** Part iv.) Describes the licensing and regulation of hog trappers/transporters (suppliers) for the terminal facility.

**Page 10.** 2) Summarization of the new feral swine regulations.
