

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2013-163

REQUESTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND
GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS STUDY ISSUES AND PREPARE RECOMMENDATIONS
CONCERNING NONCONSENT TOWING AND THE ARKANSAS TOWING AND RECOVERY
BOARD.

towed; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Towing and Recovery Board is charged with the

nonconsent towing warrant study by the Senate Committee on State Agencies and
Governmental affairs in order to identify those pressing concerns of the
general public and to prepare recommendations for resolution of those
concerns,

GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS OF THE 89TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

study issues concerning nonconsent towing and regulation of the nonconsent
towing industry to identify those pressing concerns of the general public, to
prepare recommendations for resolution of those concerns, and for other
purposes.
