<a href="#">HJR1001</a>	Barnett	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO RAISE REVENUES TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY AS HIGHWAY REVENUES; TO IMPROVE SURFACE TRANSPORTATION AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE STATE.
<a href="#">HJR1003</a>	D. Hutchinson	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO CLARIFY THE TERMS OF HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS AND AT-LARGE HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS; TO ALLOW THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO AMEND THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION.
<a href="#">HJR1004</a>	Nickels	A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO REPEAL ANNUAL SESSIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND PROVIDE THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL MEET IN REGULAR SESSION ONE TIME EVERY TWO YEARS.
<a href="#">HJR1005</a>	Clemmer	TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE THAT THIRTY-FIVE PERCENT (35%) OF THE TOTAL LOTTERY PROCEEDS SHALL BE USED TO FUND SCHOLARSHIPS.
<a href="#">HJR1006</a>	Baird	TO AMEND SECTION 15 OF ARTICLE 6 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ARKANSAS TO REQUIRE THAT A VOTE BY TWO-THIRDS (2/3) MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS REQUIRED TO OVERRIDE A VETO.
<a href="#">HJR1007</a>	Pierce	TO AMEND AMENDMENT 35 OF THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ARKANSAS STATE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION.
<a href="#">HJR1008</a>	Baird	TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO CREATE THE RAINY DAY TRUST FUND.
<a href="#">HJR1009</a>	King	TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE CHOOSING OF ELECTORS FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.
<a href="#">HJR1010</a>	Ingram	TO STREAMLINE ARKANSAS GOVERNMENT BY AMENDING THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO ABOLISH THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES OF COMMISSIONER OF STATE LANDS AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR.
<a href="#">HJR1013</a>	L. Cowling	AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE THAT THE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION SHALL BE GOVERNED IN THE SAME MANNER AS ALL OTHER STATE AGENCIES.
