About the UAMS Arkansas Geriatric Education Collaborative (AGEC)

- \$3.71M 5-year Geriatric Workforce Enhancement Program (GWEP) grant, funded by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA)
 - Annual funding for Alzheimer's Disease & Related Dementias education and support
- Mission: Provide high-quality programs that support healthy aging in Arkansas for older adults
- Provide free community and health professional programs focused on geriatric training and education
- Emphasis on educating both paid and unpaid caregivers on best practices regarding Alzheimer's Disease and other dementias



Alzheimer's and Caregiving in Arkansas

- Approx. 58,000 Arkansans age 65+ have Alzheimer's Disease
- 6th leading cause of death in Arkansas
- 8th highest Alzheimer's death rate in America
- 239% increase in Alzheimer's deaths since 2000
- 1 in 4 adults in Arkansas are caregivers, 60% are women
- More than 40% of caregivers in Arkansas are providing unpaid care to a loved one with Alzheimer's disease or another dementia



AGEC & Dementia-Focused Programs

Three overall program categories:

- Workforce Education
 - Healthcare professionals, First Responders, customer-facing workforce
- Unpaid/Family Caregivers
- Older adults & the lay community



AD-focused webinars and CDP Certification

Healthcare professionals

Webinars

- 2 webinars focused on Alzheimer's Disease (AD) annually
 - Participants include nurses, physicians, pharmacists, physical therapists, etc.
 - 321 AD webinar participants grant-to-date

Certified Dementia Practitioner ® Certification

- 8 Hour seminar and certification with an emphasis on best practices in dementia care for HCW, DCW, healthcare students, etc.
 - 282 participants grant-to-date

2 Clinical Training Partnerships

- ARcare, a federally qualified health center (FQHC)
 - Direct training partnership with 5 rural AR clinics
- UAMS Thomas and Lyon Longevity Clinic (TLLC) in the Donald W. Reynolds Institute on Aging

Age-Friendly Health System Certification

- Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) and The John A. Hartford Foundation provide "4Ms" framework for attaining Level I and II Certification as an Age-Friendly Health System
 - 4Ms: Mobility, Medication, What Matters, and Mentation
 - UAMS TLLC: Attained Level 1 Certification Jan 2021
 - ARcare: 2 clinics Level 2 Certified; 3 clinics Level 1 Certified
 - 79 healthcare staff trained grant-to-date



First Responder Dementia Training

- 3-4 hour course for police officers, firefighters, EMT, disaster relief, and other first responders
 - Includes topics such as wandering, understanding dementia signs and symptoms, elder justice, etc.
 - Offered both in-person and self-paced online
 - Partnerships with AR State Police,
 Pulaski Co. Sheriff's Dept., Benton PD,
 UAMS Police
 - 1,250+ trained grant-to-date

AGEC is a State Lead of Dementia Friendly Arkansas, part of Dementia Friendly America.



Dementia Friends

- Someone who "learns about what it's like to live with dementia and then turns that understanding into action" (dementiafriendsusa.org)
- Offer live 1-hour Awareness Sessions to business professionals, students, lay community, and older adults
- 121 trained grant-to-date

Dementia Friends Champions

- Leaders of Dementia Friends Awareness Sessions
- ▼ 19 trained grant-to-date

Dementia-Friendly Business Training

- Local businesses (retail, restaurants, banks, healthcare, etc.) receive staff training on topics such as:
 - Recognizing the signs of dementia
 - Tips for communicating with people with dementia
 - Creating a dementia-friendly physical space
- 106 trained grant-to-date



Family Caregiver Workshop




- 2-hour program for family caregivers of loved ones with Alzheimer's or another dementia
- Topics: Diagnosis of dementia, creating a care plan, caregiver self-care, addressing behaviors, etc.
- Offered in-person, virtually, and self-paced online
 - AGEC Website: 10 short video modules (can watch all or select some)
- 620 participants and online views grant-to-date




Alzheimer's/Dementia Experience: Take a Walk in Their Shoes

- 10-15 minute experience created to simulate the experience of older adults with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias
 - Use of external "distractors" such as textured gloves, discolored goggles, "tinnitus" sounds, etc.
 - Can be used in group or individual settings
 - Geared toward healthcare settings and community
- 305 participants grant-to-date





Understanding Dementia and Alzheimer's Disease



- 1-hour community program
- Topics: Overview of dementia and Alzheimer's Disease, risk factors, healthy aging, and dementia-friendly communication skills
- Offered in-person, virtually, and selfpaced online
 - UAMS PatientsLearn
- 317 participants grant-to-date
