Dr. William H. Thomas is an international authority on geriatric medicine and eldercare, dedicated to promoting and developing constructive, holistic approaches to aging and the care of our elders. He is the founder of The Eden Alternative, and also the Green House. Dr. Thomas won the America's Award, established by Norman Vincent Peale, sometimes called "The Nobel Prize for Goodness" in 1997. He also has been honored by the Giraffe Project, which awards people who "stick their necks out" to advance the common good. Most recently, Dr. Thomas has been honored with the Heinz Award for the Human Condition. His books include What Are Old People For?; How Elders Will Save the World; Learning from Hannah; and Life Worth Living, which explores the concept of The Eden Alternative and its impact on long-term care.
