How to figure your maximum grant award based on this formula:

- 1. Start with base amount. If the CASA program is the only CASA program housed in an organization, the base is \$12,000. If more than one CASA program is housed, it is a total of \$12,000 for all CASA programs.
- 2. Add amounts for each county you serve or plan to serve for the next year, including your "home" county. The number of cases will be determined from attorney ad litem figures (See Attachment B). If you believe these numbers are not correct, please contact the state office.
- 3. Add funds based on additional cases served by volunteers. ONLY dependency-neglect cases served by volunteers may be counted. Use the average from your previous four quarterly reports to determine the number.
