HOUSE BILL 1010

"AN ACT TO REPEAL ACT 318 OF 1969 [ARK. STAT. 75-702.1],
PROHIBITING THE USE OF PARKING LIGHTS ALONE TO THEREBY PERMIT
THE DAYLIGHT USE OF PARKING OR RUNNING LIGHTS WITHOUT ALSO
REQUIRING THE OPERATION OF HEADLIGHTS WHILE DRIVING; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Act 318 of 1969 and all laws or parts of laws amendatory thereto, the same being Arkansas Statutes 75-702.1, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly of Arkansas that the continuous operation of parking or running lights during the daylight hours will improve the visibility of motor vehicles on Arkansas streets and highways, that Act 318 of 1969 prohibits this, and that it is therefore necessary to repeal Act 318 of 1969 to permit the use of parking or running lights during the daylight hours to improve the visibility of motor vehicles on Arkansas streets and highways. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
