"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (d) OF SECTION 2 AND SECTION 4 OF
ACT 374 OF 1987; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of Section 2 of Act 374 of 1987 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(d) The Livestock and Poultry Commission is hereby authorized to promulgate regulations regarding horse shows, trail rides and other events or congregations of horses or other equidae for the purpose of preventing the spread of equine infections anemia."

SECTION 2. Section 4 of Act 374 of 1987 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. Any person who sells or exchanges ownership of any equidae in this State without having the required certification; or any person or chief official of a livestock market, public horse auction, or other sales event who sells or offers for sale equidae without proper certification shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and each violation shall constitute a separate offense."

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
