"AN ACT TO DECLARE THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE THE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE  
OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The English language shall be the official language  
of the State of Arkansas.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this  
Act are hereby repealed.
