HOUSE BILL 1020

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF PAWN SHOPS
WITHIN THIS STATE TO REQUIRE PROOF OF OWNERSHIP PRIOR TO
ACCEPTING AN ITEM IN PAWN, OR TO FINGERPRINT THE PERSON
PAWNING THE ITEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Every owner and operator of pawn shops doing business in this State shall, as a condition to accepting an item in pawn, require proof of ownership of the item or fingerprint the person pawning the item.

SECTION 2. The violation of this Act is a class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 3. This Act is supplemental to and in addition to all other laws pertaining to pawn shops, and shall not be deemed as repealing any of such laws.
