HOUSE BILL 1029

"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (B) OF SECTION 23 OF ACT 876 OF 1973, AS AMENDED [ARK. STAT. 13-349(B)], TO ALLOW THE DEDUCTION FROM THE PAYROLL OF A STATE EMPLOYEE, AT HIS REQUEST, FOR ARKANSAS STATE POLICE ASSOCIATION DUES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (B) of Section 23 of Act 876 of 1973, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statute 13-349(B), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(B) Payroll Deductions. Deductions from the payrolls of State employees, both regular and extra help, shall be permitted only for the following purposes: (1) withholding taxes; (2) Social Security contributions; (3) contributions to any State Retirement System or approved plan of deferred compensation; (4) group hospital and medical, and life insurance deductions; (5) payments to State employees' credit unions; (6) value of maintenance (perquisites); (7) payment of union dues when requested in writing by State employees; (8) purchase of United States Government Savings Bonds; (9) Arkansas Public Employees Association, Inc. dues when requested in writing by State employees; (10) Riders fees for participation in the Arkansas State Employees Association Van-Pool Program when requested in writing by State employees; (11) contributions to the major federated fund-raising organization when authorized by State employees; (12) Arkansas State Police Association dues when authorized in writing by State employees; and (13) for such other purposes as are specifically authorized by law, but not enumerated in this subsection. Provided, that such deductions as are authorized by this subsection shall be made in compliance with rules, regulations and procedures established by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
