HOUSE BILL 1053

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A VIETNAM WAR VETERAN LICENSE PLATE; AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Each Arkansas resident who is a veteran of the Vietnam War shall be entitled to receive a special permanent Vietnam veteran's license plate for one automobile registered pursuant to subsection (A) of Section 24 of Act 65 of 1929, as amended, or for one Class One truck as defined by subsection (C) of Section 24 of Act 65 of 1929, as amended. The license plate shall be issued by the Department of Finance and Administration upon application containing certification by the United States Department of Defense of the applicant's status as a Vietnam War veteran. The fee for the special plate shall be the same fee as charged for the regular registration plates issued for the motor vehicle. Any person desiring the special plate for more than one motor vehicle may receive extra plates and shall be charged Ten Dollars (\$10.00) plus the regular registration fee for each motor vehicle.

SECTION 2. The license plates issued pursuant to this Act shall be numbered consecutively and shall begin with the letters "V". The license plate shall display the words "Vietnam Veteran."

SECTION 3. The Commissioner of Revenues is hereby authorized to adopt reasonable rules and regulations regarding proof of the eligibility of an applicant for the special plate and such other rules and regulations not inconsistent with this Act as he deems necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are

hereby repealed.
