HOUSE BILL 1060

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY MEMBER OF THE HOUSE WHO IS CHAIRMAN OF A COMMITTEE OTHER THAN THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, JOINT AUDIT, OR JOINT BUDGET SHALL NOT SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OR VICE-CHAIRMAN OF ANY OTHER COMMITTEE; TO PROVIDE THAT NO MEMBER OF THE HOUSE WHO SERVES AS VICE-CHAIRMAN OF ANY COMMITTEE OTHER THAN THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, JOINT AUDIT, OR JOINT BUDGET SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OR VICE-CHAIRMAN OF ANY OTHER COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No member of the House of Representatives while serving as the chairman of any standing committee, select committee or joint interim committee, other than the Legislative Council, the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, or the Joint Budget Committee may serve as the chairman or vice-chairman of any other standing, select or joint interim committee. No member of the House of Representatives while serving as vice-chairman of any standing committee, select committee or joint interim committee, other than the Legislative Council, the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, or the Joint Budget Committee may serve as the chairman or vice-chairman of any other standing, select or joint interim committee.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
