HOUSE BILL 1063

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ACT 177 OF 1975 [ARK. STAT.
80-1252.1] TO ALLOW A SCHOOLTEACHER TO TRANSFER A MAXIMUM OF
FORTY-FIVE DAYS OF SICK LEAVE TO ANOTHER SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 177 of 1975, the same being Arkansas Statutes 80-1252.1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Whenever a schoolteacher employed by a school district in this State shall leave said school district and accept employment in another school district in this State, said teacher shall be granted credit by such new school district for any unused sick leave accumulated by said teacher in the former school district, but not to exceed a maximum of forty-five (45) days. Said accumulated and unused sick leave credit shall be granted to the teacher upon furnishing proof in writing thereof from the school district of former employment of the teacher."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
