HOUSE BILL 1066

"AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE KANSAS CITY SOUTHERN RAILWAY  
DEPOT IN MENA, ARKANSAS AS A STATE TOURIST INFORMATION  
CENTER TO BE STAFFED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND  
TOURISM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Kansas City Southern Railway depot in Mena, Arkansas is hereby established as a state tourist information center at such time as the governing body of the City of Mena enacts an ordinance agreeing to the same. Upon adoption of such ordinance, it shall be the duty of the Department of Parks and Tourism to provide personnel to staff the tourist information center. The City of Mena is not required by this Act to transfer ownership of the depot to the State.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
